



“All Things Are Possible”

I. **Mark 9:14-27**

A. If thou can do anything...

1. Jesus' reply places responsibility back on man: *“If you can believe...” (Amp – “You say to me, If you can do anything? Why, all things are possible to him who believes.”)*
2. Message Bible – *“If? There are no ‘ifs’ among believers. Anything can happen.”*

B. **“Help my unbelief”**

1. Religious songs and prayers have been associated with this statement in error (much like Job's phrase “The Lord gives and the Lord takes away...”)
2. Notice Jesus did not respond to this statement. Why? There is no help for unbelief. You must rid yourself of it entirely. Faith is the only thing that pleases God (**Hebrews 11:6**).

II. **Mark 11:20-24**

A. Take the limits off!

1. According to this scripture, there are no limits to what faith can do!
2. The only limits are the ones we build up in our heart. Moving a mountain is easier than we think (key word – think) (Words moving words).

B. **II Corinthians 10:3-5**

1. This is the key to seeing what appears to be impossible become reality. If you can see it, you can achieve it.
2. People only receive small because they believe small. If Moses could part the Red Sea, if Joshua could stop the earth for rotating for ½ a day, if Elijah can call down fire from heaven, if 3 men could be thrown in a burning fiery furnace with no harm or even the smell of smoke, if Daniel can come out of a lion's den without any harm, then why does things seem so impossible to you? And all of that was Old Testament. In the New Testament, Jesus revealed the true nature of dominion by walking on water, speaking to winds and waves, healing the sick and raising the dead. Nothing is impossible to you if you can believe....Stop thinking so much and just start believing!
3. **Genesis 15:1-6** Do you know why God told Abraham to count the stars? To see things the way God sees them. With the naked (natural) eye, man can see only around 2,500 stars on a dark night. But God obviously was thinking bigger than what the natural man could receive (**I Corinthians 2:14**). Our Galaxy contains roughly 100 billion stars. Start counting so you can believe!
4. Man thinks in addition, God thinks in multiplication: 1 can put a thousand , 2 can put 10,000 / With God it is always more...we just need to see things from His point of view.
