- I. **Psalm 146:1-11**
 - A. God is Always With You
 1. Jesus said, I will never leave you or forsake you.
 2. Be Still....Rest and Know
 - What do you know? Do you know that nothing is impossible to God!
 - Do you Rest on His Word?
 - B. **II Chronicles 32:8**
 1. Do you know what it means to “Experience God’s Rest”?
 2. Learning How to allow the peace of God to Rule your heart (**Colossians 3:15**)

- II. **I Kings 19:9-12**
 - A. The Still (Quiet, calm) Small voice of God
 1. “Be still....so you can hear the still voice of God.”
 2. When we are quiet, God’s voice becomes louder!
 - God is speaking...the question is, are we listening?
 - Jesus spoke of the prayer closet for the simple reason of learning how to shut the door on every distraction that keeps you from God’s Presence. (**Matthew 6:6**).
 3. When we are humble (small), we place ourselves in the proper position to hear and to receive (Positional Authority).
 - B. Watch out for the stranger’s voice
 1. **John 10:5**
 - Have you become acquainted with the stranger’s voice and allowed it to take the place of God’s gentle voice?
 - Notice the word “Know” – We should turn from the stranger and run to our Father.
 2. **Proverbs 7:1-5, vs. 21**
