I. **Luke 8:26-39**

A. The Possessed Man

1. Mark 5 shares insight as well...He was in the mountains and in the tombs, cutting himself with stones (People that cut, pull their hair out, or try to harm themselves...if they like dark places, or graves, etc.... harassed by demons).
2. He was bound by chains, but the demon (fallen angel) had supernatural strength so the chains would not hold (seven sons of Sceva and one demon).
3. Mark 5 says He saw Jesus and came and worshipped Him.....either the man was crying out for help or the demon controlled the man to try to hurt Jesus until he got close in His presence, and it caused the demon to bow his knee!

B. Look at the order of business

1. Jesus commanded the demon to come out.....and it did not.
2. Jesus then asked what his name was....(a head demon that needed a little more effort and work to be done....remember the disciples couldn't cast a demon out of the young boy when they tried).
3. Demons did not want to leave their area of habitation – 2000 pigs.
4. When Jesus freed the man, everyone else was afraid. It's still the same way today – Preachers would rather just leave the devil alone instead of facing him!

II. **Mark 7:31-37**

A. Understanding the Deaf and Dumb Spirit

1. A demon has a hold on their ears and mouth.
2. Jesus said, “Be open!” (boy that we prayed for with autism)

B. Other evidence of being demonized (possessed)

1. **Restlessness, Torment, Nightmares, Addiction** (young lady who chanted in foreign language).
2. **Enticed to do evil, Defilement of Self, Illnesses with no cure.**
3. **Mental Illness, Unreasonable Fear, Unbending Religiosity** (Mormons, Jehovah's witness).

C. How to Minister Deliverance

1. **The patient must be willing. (Have the patient prepared....off of drugs, repentant, forgiving, and saved).**
2. **Command through the Prayer of Faith (The Name and the Blood).**
3. **Have the patient speak his deliverance from Satan's grip** (man in prison).
4. **Rejoice in the Lord and Pray in the Spirit.**
