Bible Types & Numbers

I. *II Timothy 2:15*

A. **Rightly Dividing**

1. **Properly Dissecting; Make a Straight Cut**
2. You go from READING to Meditating, Researching, Studying

B. Categories of "Types"

1. **Topical**: One Truth from the N.T. represented by several types from the O.T.
 - Jesus as the Lion of Judah (L), the Ark (A), the Manna (M), and the Brazen Serpent (B) - Lamb
2. **Standard** – One O.T. type always representing one N.T. anointing
 - Objects – oil represents the Holy Spirit and His anointing (I Sam. 16:13)
 - Double Types and Double Meanings – Noah's ark: Jesus coming the first time to bring us salvation and the second coming on His return (**I Peter 3:20, Matthew 24:37**)
3. **Unique** – The O.T. type used one once for a N.T. truth
 - **Jacob's ladder** – **John 1:51**
 - **Brazen serpent** – **John 3:14**
4. **Objects**
 - Colors (White for purity), Metals (Gold - heavenly glory), Natural Phenomena (fire – judgment), Natural objects (wood – human carnality), Food (Bread – spiritual food), Man made objects (sword – Word of God), Animals (Ox – servant, service), Places (Egypt – Society, world), Actions (Washing – Spiritual Cleansing)
5. **Ceremonies**
 - Burning Incense – Praise, Lighting the lamp stand – Anointing of the Holy Spirit, Seven Feasts of the Lord – Full plan of God for the ages
6. **Numbers** – Will study next week
7. **People** – Noah, Joseph, David (types of Jesus) – Melchizedek (**Hebrews 7:1-3**)

II. Genesis Types

A. Types in Genesis

1. Chapter 2 & 3 (note: no types in Genesis 1; it is all revealed history.)
2. **Genesis 2:2** – Sabbath (Hebrew for rest is type of heavenly rest seen in **Revelation 22:1-5**)
3. **Genesis 2:8-15** – Eden paradise or our position with the Father (Tree of Life – Salvation / River – Water of Life (rivers of living water) / Adam – type of Jesus / Eve – type of the church / **Genesis 3:7** Fig Leaf type of self-righteousness)
4. Genesis 6-9 – Flood (Judgment) / Ark – Type of Jesus (Refer to study guide)
