I. **Galatians 3:13-14**

A. **The Curse**

1. *Evil or misfortune that has been invoked upon someone; to afflict with evil.*
2. *A cause of great harm or misfortune; torment.*

B. The Curse....What is it? Why is it Here?

1. *Deuteronomy 28:15-68*
2. Sickness, Poverty, Confusion, Despair, Hardship, & Pain
3. Disobedience/Separation from God

C. Redemption must be received and held fast to

1. Christ has redeemed....He made a way of escape; He paid the price!
2. If separation from God is what brought the curse, then returning to God is the first step of eliminating it from your life.
3. **James 4:7-8**
 - *Submit
 - *Resist

- **Words are powerful; some people live under the curse of their own words. Start learning how to speak God's Words over your life today and your future!**

II. The Blessing of Abraham vs. The Curse

A. **Luke 13:10-16**

1. Facts: 1.) This woman had a curse in her life for 18 years. 2.) Satan was the author of the curse. 3.) Jesus was the answer to the curse
2. Daughter of Abraham – Jesus said this to identify 1 major thing: Relationship (Identity)
3. The Blessing of Abraham – Make your name great; you will be blessed so you can be a blessing!

B. Claim God's blessing and rebuke the curse

1. Submit to God and Resist the devil (Receive & Rebuke)
2. **Rebuke – Tax upon, censure, forbid (Jesus rebuked the fever on Peter's mother-in-law because it was identified in Deuteronomy 28:22 as a part of the curse.)**
