



I. **Psalm 91:1-7**

A. Exposed or Covered?

1. God set in motion a plan in the beginning; When the first man and the first woman sinned in the garden, they sewed fig leaves together to cover their nakedness.
2. Man's way of doing things has never worked....why? Because it is only temporary. What we need more than ever, is the covering plan of God. It is within this covering, that we are protected, safe, and secure.
3. When you go to work and you know by the forecast that it is going to rain, what do you take with you? There is a lot of rain in the forecast, and we must shield ourselves from getting wet! It is time to start walking on the water instead of sinking under it.

B. *Under His Wings You Will Trust*

1. There is no safety without trust!
2. This is why there are so many beliefs, so many lies from the enemy....I have come to realize that very few people fully understand what Trust is, and if they do, seldom is it found among Christians with their Leader at their head.
  - **Trust—Firm belief in the reliability, truth, ability, or strength of someone.**
  - **Trust (Hebrew) – To Make Your Refuge; Be Confident and Sure.**
3. Do You Trust in the Lord and lean not to your own ways? (**Proverbs 3:5-6**).

II. Garments and Coverings

A. Last Week... *“We need Jesus (our covering) in every aspect of our lives.”*

1. **Romans 13:14** *“Put on the Lord Jesus....”* (Make Him your priority, make Him your covering for your family, your health, your mind, your finances...)
2. When you put on Jesus, you put on the most powerful symbol of redemption...the one thing that Satan forgot when he manipulated the people to crucify our Lord.....**The Blood Is More Than Enough!**

B. Armor of God, Robe of Righteousness, Garment of Praise

1. **Ephesians 6:11** *“Put on the whole armor of God...”*
2. **Isaiah 61:10** *“He hath clothed me with the garments of salvation and the robe of righteousness.”* (I am no longer a slave or a servant; I am a child of the Risen King; Satan cannot accuse me...he cannot take from me...I am covered on every side!)
3. **Isaiah 61:3** *“Put on the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness...”*
  - Depression is rampant, trying to take hold of every mind and every heart today; our youth are crying out for their identity.
  - When you put on praise, you put on God's power....His identity becomes yours. Give the devil no place!
