I. **Philippians 4:19-20**

A. The Difference between Supply and Meet

1. **Supply – To Cram, To Furnish, To Satisfy**
2. **Meet – Barely Enough**
 - Supply recognizes the need and goes over and beyond
 - Sunday’s message – My cup runs over....Overflow

B. **Genesis 22:13-14**

1. Jehovah Jireh – The Lord who sees our needs and provides!
2. God sees where you are....He sees your needs...and He always provides!
 - * **Matthew 6:8** “He knows what you have need of before you ask...”
 - * **Matthew 6:30** “If God clothes the grass of the field...”

- <i>Our thinking must be renewed to the Word, and we must remember what He has done before: If He does anything for one, He will do it for all!</i>

- <i>God’s provision is not based upon your righteousness; It is based upon your faith to receive it!</i>

A. The Children in the Wilderness

1. Cloud by day, Fire by night, manna to eat for 40 years (**Exodus 13:21**)
2. **Deuteronomy 28:5** (Shoes and Raiment remained intact).
3. What was the error in their journey? They saw the miracles in Egypt with the 10 plagues, they saw the parting of the red sea, they saw the water pour from a rock...but they forgot all of those things and refused to believe.

B. **II Kings 4:1-7**

1. Provision through action...
2. Sound familiar to Jesus feeding 5000?

C. **I Kings 17:11-16**

1. First – the best (Firstfruits)
2. Give God your best....He already gave you His!
