- WVC "Health To All Your Flesh" part 1 May 10, 2023

I. Proverbs 4:20-23

- A. Health
 - 1. Marpe (Hebrew): Curative, Medicine, Cure; Deliverance, Healing, Remedy, Wholesome.
 - 2. What is health to you? Strength, Balance, Feeling Good or Normal?
 * Sickness has become such a norm in many people's lives, that they have forgotten what it feels like to be well.

* The message is this: Find your healing and receive your wholeness!

- B. All Your Flesh
 - 1. I Thessalonians 5:23 "Spirit, Soul, and Body."
 - 2. Your Body and its makeup/structure is your flesh. This includes your bones, your brain, your heart, your intestines, your eyes, your skin...etc.
 - 3. Health To All Your Flesh.
- II. Answering some important questions...
 - A. Is Healing For Today?
 - 1. The answer can be found in answering another question: Is Salvation for Today?
 - 2. *Mark 16:18 and James 5:14* (Healing has not passed away....it's been here all along.)
 - B. Is Healing For All?
 - 1. Is Salvation for All? But why are many not saved? (The answer to this shows the first and most important factor concerning healing....Choose it).
 - 2. Another way to answer this question is to look at Jesus; He is the same yesterday, today, and forever:
 - Acts 10:38, Matthew 4:24, Matthew 12:15, Luke 4:40, Luke 6:19 (any questions?)
 - God is no respecter of persons (What He does for one, He will do for all).
 - C. Does God use sickness to teach His children?
 - 1. Do you use sickness to teach your children?
 - 2. There is no place in the Bible that mentions Jesus telling someone to suffer with sickness while they learned humility and trust. Jesus simply healed everyone that came to Him to receive.

D. Where does sickness come from?

- 1. See the truth and the truth will make you free: Sickness is a *symptom* that comes from separation from God (*Psalm 103:2-3*).
- 2. And who was present in the garden when Adam and Eve ran from God? Sickness is the handywork of Satan that exists because of the curse!
- 3. All Sickness is under the curse...but *Galatians 3:13* is our answer!
