



“Laborers for the Kingdom” Sun Feb 4, 2024

I. **Luke 10:1-2**

A. What Exactly is God Looking For?

1. Someone Willing
2. Someone Ready
 - God is not looking for someone without flaws or imperfections; History has shown that He works best through those who have nothing to offer but a willing heart (fisherman, tax collector, persecutor....)
 - *“God chooses the foolish things of this world to confound the wise...”*

B. How Can I Be a Laborer?

1. In order to be a laborer, you must be a leader; and in order to be a leader, you must first be a believer...
2. What is a leader?
 - In the simplest of terms, *a leader is the inspiration for and the director of an action.*
 - A Godly Leader is not moved by circumstances, people, or emotions; he is moved by only one thing....The Voice of God! (There are way to many “followers” of the system....God needs leaders for the Kingdom).
3. What is a believer?
 - Here is where real separation begins: Do you believe in Jesus? Do you believe in Jesus from a heavenly perspective or an earthly one? (most Christians look at Jesus only from a heavenly one...they look forward to seeing Him when they get to heaven, but seeing Jesus here in the present...on this earth...in the “right now” is the key to real faith (belief).
 - **Mark 16:17-20** *“These signs shall follow them that believe (Have faith)...”*
4. If you want to be a laborer, then you must have an identity...and in order to have an identity, you must have a purpose (This is simply...someone willing and ready).

II. You are more capable than you know...

A. **1 Corinthians 3:1-9**

1. One plants, another waters....(Every thing you do in this life...everything you say in this life is a seed....one action, one word...it can change a life forever!)
2. This is all God is looking for...not someone educated or eloquent in speech; just someone willing and ready; someone quick to obey.

B. **Mark 16:20** “The Lord working with them...”

1. “I can’t pray for someone”, “I can’t cast out a devil or lay hands on someone...” – Stop saying what the devil wants you to believe....
2. “What if it doesn’t work?” – Focus on the work and let God do His.
