Ι. **Romans 8:1-2**

- A. Condemnation
 - **1.** Adverse Sentence (Verdict)
 - 2. When someone or something is condemned, they are sentenced to a particular punishment, like death; when a building is condemned, it is declared unfit for occupancy.
- B. I am redeemed
 - 1. A greater law has made me free; but there is still that lingering tactic from the enemy....always questioning, always trying to keep me bound!
 - 2. The law of the Spirit of Life.....is greater than any other law that tries to condemn me. All I need to do is receive it!
- Going from the old man to the new man....this is what makes the difference in this life!
- Old things are passed away....behold, all things are become new!
- Π. Jesus (His heart and yours)

A. John 8:10-11

- 1. Jesus is not in the condemning business; He is in the saving business.
- 2. This is why the street preachers who speak out of a voice of condemnation have it all wrong; people already know what they are guilty of....
- 3. How does one make a difference? Show them God's grace just like Jesus did!
- 4. This is the real heart of Jesus: Love people into the kingdom instead of judging them or passing a sentence on them. Shouldn't we carry the same attitude?

B. I John 3:20-23

- 1. The condemned heart: One of the hardest things for the believer to overcome....why? Simply because we believe a lie rather than the truth.
- 2. The only way to have confidence in God is by having a pure heart. We have condemned ourselves more than Satan could ever imagine; in turn, we become our own enemy.
- 3. This is why speaking the Word over and over, meditating day and night, keeping the Word in front of your eyes....keeps you, protects you, honors you!
