l. James 1:12-17

- A. What you need to know...
 - 1. # 1 and most important: Know Your God; He is not the tempter!
 - *Tempt (Peirazo): To Test or Entice
 - * Let no man say, "God is testing me!" (God doesn't cause or allow things to happen in order to try your faith or your character....why? Because He is good!)
 - 2. # 2 Know your enemy
 - * I Peter 5:8 "Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary, the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour."
 - * Satan is not all-knowing; he only has the ability to look and attempt to draw you into temptation; remember, he is subtle and deceptive
 - 3. # 3 Know the progression
 - * Drawn away, enticement, conception, sin
 - * The tree in the garden is a perfect example (learn how to be in the right place all the time!)
- B. I Corinthians 10:13
 - 1. God will always make a way of escape
 - 2. The broad spectrum of temptations can be classified under only 3 types (Lust of the Flesh, Lust of the Eyes, and the Pride of Life) I JN 2:16
 - *Lust of the Flesh: Food, Sex, Thrills
 - * Lust of the Eyes: Clothes, Money, Entertainment
 - * Pride of Life: Recognition, Praise, Power
- Satan knows what triggers you to be drawn away; stay away from the trigger!
- II. What Would Jesus Do?
 - A. Submit Yourself to God
 - 1. James 4:7
 - 2. Remember, your ability to resist depends upon your position with God
 - 3. When you are submitted, you are resting on what God says (Jesus was tested all the time by the religious; how did he keep things together?)
 - B. Speak the Written Word
 - 1. Luke 4:1-4, vs. 8, vs. 12
 - 2. Notice how Satan comes questioning your identity in every temptation (IF)
 - 3. When you speak the Word of God with authority, Satan will flee!
