



“Power in His Name”

I. **Philippians 2:5-11**

A. Jesus – The Meaning and The Power

1. ***Yahweh Saves; The Lord is Salvation***
2. The Name Jesus was quite popular in first century Judea; for this reason, our Lord is often mentioned in the Bible as “Jesus of Nazareth.” Despite its commonness, the name Jesus is remarkably significant. Jesus was sent by God for a specific purpose and calling and His name bears witness to that mission.

B. Jesus – The Power

1. What was the mission? ***Galatians 4:4-7 (To Save, Adopt, and Empower)***
2. These 2 scriptures gives us great insight into how God did what He did and why – the dual significance of His name: Jesus was “from one angle”, just another “Joshua”, showing the reality of humbling himself, completely emptying Himself of His Heavenly Glory, and coming as the “son of man”, but yet in another sense, He was the true Joshua, the one who would live up to the name like no other person could!
3. There is power and authority in the person of Jesus...no doubt, but what people have missed is the representation of who Jesus is through the designation of His name!

II. Believing His Name

A. ***John 1:12***

1. Who are you? I am no longer a servant, but a child of God.
2. As a child, you have rights and privileges....but if you do not believe and accept those rights that are given through His Name, you will never fully accomplish God’s plan here on this earth.

B. ***Luke 10:1-2, 17-20***

1. *“Even the devils are subject TO US through your name.”* What power, what exhilaration, to know that Satan and his kingdom has no authority over me!
2. Look at the response of Jesus *“I saw Satan fall from the sky like a flash of lightning!”* – *Something significant happened...the prince of the power of the air was shaken from his dominion, moved from his place of authority...the day that men took up their rightful identity, everything changed!*
3. Jesus followed up with the explanation of how to walk in that power every day, but finished it by stating the importance of realizing that authority over Satan is normal and expectant of every child of God!

C. It’s one thing to speak the name, It’s another thing to Speak it In Faith!

1. What’s the difference? One hopes and the other expects!

2. ***Acts 3:2-8 / Acts 3:16*** (The Name and Faith in His Name....No doubt, No Fear, Only Expectation and Belief).
3. Don't be like the sons of Sceva in ***Acts 19:15*** – This is not something you try, It is something you do!
