

## ١. Luke 21:7-11, vs. 25-28

- A. What is a sign?
  - 1. Semeion (Greek): Miracle, Sign, Token
  - 2. Miracle: A surprising event that is not explained by natural or scientific laws
- B. The Heavens Above (Fearful sights)
  - 1. Our sun
    - \*We have already experienced an increased amount of solar activity in the last 6 months.
    - \* On January 29 2022, 40 of the 49 Space X satellites were destroyed by a solar flare/ There are 5 levels of solar flares (A, B, C, M, and X); on February 14, there was an X-class flare that triggered some radio blackouts in the North and South Poles. In March, there have been other M-class flares that has caused a greater interest and concern.
  - 2. The Sun, Moon, & Stars (*Luke 21:25*)
    - \* What happens in the heavens will affect weather upon the earth
    - \* We have yet to see these things with our physical eyes, but things are about to increase. (Prophecy fulfillment: power grids, internet, and travel)
    - \* These things should not frighten you, but excite you. When you begin to see these things come to pass, look up.

## II. God's Rainbow

## A. Genesis 9:12-17

- 1. God's first sign of His covenant
- 2. 2 other places that the rainbow is mentioned: *Revelation 4:3 & 10:1*
- 3. Every time you see a rainbow, you should remember God's covenant promises – and when you speak the Word, God remembers His Spoken Word!
- B. Seeking a Sign or Proclaiming One?
  - 1. Signs are given for the unbeliever (rainbow picture...tongues, end times)
  - 2. The believer has already received the greatest sign (Jesus Christ and Him crucified). There is no need to ask for a sign or even seek one, but rather proclaim them...
  - 3. Mark 16:15-20
  - 4. This should be our motivation and prayer Acts 4:29-31
