

"Stand and See..." Wed Nov 6, 2024

II Chronicles 20:1-3, 13-17

- A. The Revelation: The Battle is not yours, but God's!
 - 1. Are you "tired" of being tired?
 - 2. When do we learn to Rest upon the words of God?
 - 3. II Chronicles 32:7-8
- B. Stand ve still
 - 1. The italics identifies that this word is not in the original text.
 - 2. It is not to be confused with literally standing still and waiting
 - "Set yourself (Station yourself, Stand your ground)"
 - In other words, "Don't be afraid....Stand your ground and you will have your victory!"

II. Stand Your Ground = Moving Forward

A. *Hebrews* 10:38

- 1. Satan wants you to be discouraged...he wants you to lose sight of the promise ahead!
- 2. Faith only knows one direction: Forward!

B. *Ephesians* 6:10-17

- 1. Withstand Oppose, stand against, or resist
- 2. The image of our new president "Fight, Fight!"
- 3. The traditional view vs. God's view...." Fight the good fight of faith..." (I Timothy 6:12)
- 4. Notice how many times the word "stand" is mentioned
 - Why does a person stand? What would be some of the reasons?
 - 1. Stand in honor of someone
 - 2. Stand for the flag
 - 3. Stand to attention
 - Here is the significance: When you stand your ground, you are standing in honor of His Word, You are standing in honor of the cross, You are standing in attention to the King of Kings & Lord or Lords.....and in return, Jesus who is SEATED at the right hand of the Father, He will always STAND for you – the battle is not yours but the Lords!
