- A. When you change your words, you change your life...
 - 1. Are your words edifying and full of grace?
 - 2. Are your words judgmental and pulling down?
- B. Is it really that important?
 - 1. Matthew 12:36 "Every idle word..."
 - 2. **Matthew 5:37** "Let your yes be yes and your no be no; anything more than that comes of evil."
 - **3.** I Thessalonians 4:11 "Study to be quiet." (It takes effort to speak differently; it takes effort to keep quiet and mind your own business!).
 - **4. Proverbs 17:28** "Even a fool when he holds his peace is counted wise..."
- II. By your words you will be justified (set free) or condemned (placed in bondage) A. Judge Not....

1. Matthew 7:1-2

- The measure you meet the law of sowing and reaping.
- What you dish out will come back to you!
- Are your words judgmental in nature; are they critical, full of impatience and anger? (Satan takes advantage of ill-spoken words to bring judgment into your life....Don't be ignorant of his devices...Give him no place...in your words!)
- 2. Luke 6:37
- B. Authority in Words
 - 1. *Matthew 8:5-10*
 - Speak the Word only...
 - Why did Jesus marvel? Answer: The centurion understood the authority in the spoken word!
 - 2. Calling things that be not... (*Romans 4:17*).
 - If it was important to Jesus, it should be important to you!
 - "The damsel is not dead...", "Lazarus sleeps, but I go to wake him out of sleep." - Death was not a part of His vocabulary... it shouldn't be a part of yours.
