

I. Hebrews 3:7-13

A. Harden

- 1. To Render Stubborn; destitute of spiritual perception, callous, blind.
- 2. Stubborn is the same word in the Bible as Rebellion: To turn away, revolter, disobedient, provoke.
 - Two people in the O.T. comes to mind: Pharaoh and King Saul...
 - I Samuel 15:23
- B. The Callous and Numb Generation
 - 1. Matthew 24:10-12
 - Tired of the lies, the corruption, the world in general?
 - Fed up with people?
 - 2. This is Satan's tactic so you become despondent and lose the sight of the power that is within; don't give up...keep your eyes focused and your heart alert...you will surely make it to the end!
- II. Things that will help keep you from a hardened heart
 - A. Guard Your Heart With All Diligence (Proverbs 4:23)
 - 1. Remember..."Out of the abundance of the heart, the mouth speaks..."
 - 2. Protecting what goes in your garden ensures the crop that comes out!
 - B. Keep the faith by developing it
 - 1. **Revelation 3:10-11** (Keep it and Hold fast to it).
 - 2. John 12:37-40 (Believing is the key to receiving) / Mark 16:14
 - 3. You develop your faith just like you develop your muscles exercise them....and if you don't, they will grow less significant and weak. (Believe for greater things in God....exercise your faith daily).
 - C. Keep Your Heart Open
 - 1. Have an open heart to give...
 - When you bless someone, do it with an open heart, not expecting a return (this way you want get offended if the person you blessed doesn't do what they are supposed to do with the gift – too many times, we expect something from people and our disappointment can affect what we do in the future).
 - 2. Have an open heart to receive...
 - Receiving is just as important as giving if you have a callous heart, you will become prideful and believe that you don't need anything from anyone.
