- I. **John 1:1-5**
 - A. All Things were created by Him...
 1. All things are sustained and remain in existence by the Word of God.
 2. In the beginning, God spoke...and it was!
 3. God’s Word is **Infallible – Incapable of making mistakes or being wrong; absolutely trustworthy and sure.**
 - B. **Luke 21:33** “My words will never pass away”
 1. Jesus revealed to us the very nature of God through the words that He spoke – We need to pay more attention because it is through His Words that the very life you are living and the very life that you desire to live exists.
 - **Luke 4:31-37**
 - **Matthew 8:16** “He cast out spirits with His word.”
 - **Revelation 1:16** “Out of His mouth goes a sharp two-edged sword.”
 - **Hebrews 4:12** “The Word of God is alive and sharper than a two-edged sword...”
 - **Revelation 19:13** “And His name is called the Word of God.”
 2. **Psalms 107:20** “He sent His **WORD** and healed them and delivered them from their destructions.”
 - C. What Word? **Acts 10:34-38**
 - D. Metaphorical or Literal?
- II. The Word Never Fails...Never...Never!
 - A. The Difference in Knowing the God who dwells in heaven and the One who dwells in you...
 1. Stop trying to make the Word fit your ideas, opinions, and problems and start taking responsibility and believe! (Too many people quote the Word to explain their circumstances; we must Rightly Divide the WORD of Truth / Ex: **Isaiah 60:22** “I the Lord will hasten it in his time.” – Look at **vs. 18-19** / God’s timing is Right Now!) / story of note: elevator / the difference: In Him I Live and Move and Have My Being...He dwells in me and it shows!
 2. Jesus came to...first: undo what the devil had done, but second: He came to show us how to live as kings and priests unto God (above the circumstances instead of beneath them!)
 - B. Speaking His Name
 1. God listens to every word you speak...and the devil does too!
 2. **Philippians 2:9-11**
 - Every tongue will confess...(Every language...this includes sickness).
 - **Romans 10:8** “What does it say? The **WORD** is near you...in your mouth.”
