I. **Psalm 139:1-14**

A. Omnipresent

1. **Present in all places at all times. Being Present in all places at once.**
2. It makes sense when you consider Christianity – He walks in me...He walks in you...He walks in anyone on this earth in different countries at different time zones all at the same time...for those who hear and obey His voice.

B. **Isaiah 40:28**

1. God doesn't sleep....never gets tired....never needs a vacation!
2. God is with you all the time!

II. The Old Testament vs. the New

A. **Genesis 1:1-3**

1. Spirit of God moved – Everywhere before the fall
2. **Genesis 3:8-10**
 - Adam and Eve hid themselves from the Presence of God.
 - God asked, "Where are you?" (Something was different...If God was everywhere at once, then why would He need to ask?)
 - Satan became the god of this world and God's Omnipresence was limited; This is why you see the Holy Spirit working with one prophet at one time...not a mass number of people all at once.

B. **Joel 2:28-29**

1. "And it shall come to pass afterward..." (after the cross)
2. **Acts 2:1-4**
3. **Matthew 29:19-20** "I am with you always...." (this happened after the resurrection; God was not limited any longer because Jesus said, "All power is given to me in heaven and earth.")
4. **Hebrews 13:15** "I will never leave you or forsake you."
