### I. Hebrews 3:12-13

### A. Exhortation

- 1. Greek To call near; invite, comfort
- 2. Webster Strongly encourage or urge to do something

## B. Acts 27:21-25

- 1. The situation looked grim, but God....
- 2. Paul's exhortation brought peace in a time of great trouble.
- 3. This is exactly what the church should be doing now! Encourage each other within the church and strengthen those without!
  - \* There's enough misery and negativity in this world to go around for everyone....but encouragement is needed most, but it is uncommon and hidden in the dark, as it seems.
  - \*Do you know why the news is so negative? Only One answer: Profit! (Bad news gets more attention, more clicks, and leads to more revenue.) (Interesting note: the love of money is the root of all evil).
  - \*Why do people thrive toward the negative? Beyond what they see and hear, they live under a fallen state, so they are hard-wired this way until an overhaul is made!
- God's overhaul of your life begins with being "born again". Then the renewing of the mind continues the process. That's why we are told to "think on these things."

### Word Affirmations II.

# A. Hebrews 10:23-25

- 1. How to overcome the "hard-wired" negativity: Encouragement of the Word
- 2. Positive affirmations are good, but they will not change the root. Only the Word of God is powerful enough to make a real change.
