Foundation Scripture: I Corinthians 6:17-20

I. *I Am Loved...*

A. *I John 4:15-19*

1. Past Experiences and Current Surroundings try to dictate a different picture concerning God's love toward us.
2. If there is one person that stands by what He says, it is God!
 - I will never leave you or forsake you!
 - When your father and your mother forsake you, I will take you up!

B. Nothing to be afraid of

1. *Isaiah 41:10*

2. If God loves me, that's all I need to overcome in this world. God's idea of love is much different than ours. His love is not based upon our performance...It is based upon His Son!
 - This kind of love is called UNCONDITIONAL
 - Love is patient, kind, enduring; Love bears all things, hopes all things, believes all things, rejoices in the truth...Love never fails!
 - Since God loves me, there is nothing in this world that can stand against me....even in my mistakes, God still loves me. "I am the one that Jesus loves..." Find this today, Live this today, Be who God called you to be!

II. *Walking In The Anointing (The confidence of knowing your identity/ownership)*

A. *Isaiah 10:27*

1. ***Anointing – The Richness and Splendor of God (Glory); the yoke-destroying power of God.***
2. If you want to understand true ownership, capture God's anointing!
3. Moses said, "Show me your glory (splendor, majesty)." God's response was, My Presence will go with you and I will give you rest." (***Exodus 33:14***)

B. The closer to God you get, the more anointed you become

1. Anointed to do what? "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me because He has anointed me..." - Anointed to be a witness for the Lord.
2. It is only through the anointing that you can receive your healing; it is only through the anointing that you can break free from the power of debt; it is only through the anointing that you obtain peace; the anointing is your joy!
3. I am anointed; I am a child of God; I am loved by Him; I am the one that Jesus loves; Since God is for me, nothing can stand against me...
