



# "The Power of Ownership"

## I. *I Corinthians 6:17-20*

### A. Bought with a price

1. **Bought – Purchased; Redeemed (Release or Rescue)**
2. There is no greater price, no greater love than another man who lays down his life for his friends (**John 15:13**).

### B. The Price He paid...

1. There is nothing in this world that is greater than the Blood.
2. We overcome Satan by it, We have victory over the curse that is in this world by it, We stand strong over every weakness, every attack by it. **The BLOOD, The BLOOD, the BLOOD...IT is more than enough!**
3. Too many times, we have limited the power of God, simply because we have forgotten what He did....The price He paid...The power of ownership!

- **Ownership...not in the sense that I am enslaved to a master of high demand; but rather, I am no longer a slave to anything that falls under the curse in this land!**

- **Once I submit to the one who died in my place, all fear is gone. He is my provider, my healer, my peace and my joy....I replace slavery for total victory and freedom!**

## II. The Simple Word "My"

### A. *Hebrews 10:16-23*

1. Do I have the right to call "MYself" a child of God?
2. **Romans 8:14-17**
  - Children of God...Sons and Daughters of God (**John 1:12**)
  - **Heirs – Inheritor; Possessor**

### B. What are you a possessor (owner) of?

1. Why does religion get in the way of truth? When we are proud of something we own, what do we declare? That's MY wife, That's MY husband, That's MY son (daughter), That's MY house, car, etc...
2. The enemy has convinced us to claim ownership of his bag of problems over God's promises....MY arthritis, MY poor back, MY high blood pressure...
3. If Jesus TOOK my infirmities, then shouldn't I claim ownership of what He replaced them with? If He became poor so that I might be rich, why would I claim ownership of never having enough? (**Your words validate your problem or your promise!**)
