

"What Do You See?" Sun Sept 8, 2024

Foundation Scripture: II Kings 6:14-17

I. **Ephesians 1:15-23**

- A. The Spirit of Wisdom, Revelation Knowledge, and Enlightenment to your eyes
 - 1. What a powerful prayer....that every believer must learn to incorporate daily.
 - 2. What is the goal? To Know the Truth...but we cannot know it if we cannot SEE it!
 - 3. What the Holy Spirit will teach you today is how so many people...so many Christians are living in darkness... Satan is taking advantage of so many people in this day and time...but the Spirit of the Lord is moving and it's time to put a stop to his malicious plan! II Corinthians 4:18
- B. What I See Enables Me To Know... (*Ephesians 1:18-19*) Know What?
 - 1. The Hope of His Calling (This is where you find your identity).
 - 2. The Riches of the Glory of His Inheritance (This is where you receive your earthly promises).
 - 3. The Exceeding Greatness of His Power (This is where you become the representative of Jesus). "As He is, so are we in this world."

II. Blinded Eyes

A. II Corinthians 3:12-18

- 1. Do you want to know the truth? If you want to know it, you must see it...see it how? See it the way God sees it! And Satan will do everything within his power to keep you from Seeing it God's Way....because when you see it His way, something begins to move and it certainly begins to change.
- 2. Light...the Power of God; "Let there be light" / What were the people afraid of concerning Moses? The Light!

B. John 1:1-12

- 1. The darkness did not understand the light and even though God created the world, the world did not know Him or receive Him (vs. 5, 10, 11). If the devil cannot erase God from our memory, He will try to keep us from the knowledge of the 3 mentioned above!
- 2. If you receive the light (If you can see it without turning your head or shying away from it...like Elisha refusing to leave Elijah), you will have the power to become a CHOSEN CHILD OF GOD!

3. Matthew 13:10-15

- II Corinthians 4:4 "The god of this world hath blinded the minds..."
- Example story: man who reads his Bible daily and involved in church but never saw the reality of demonic oppression or the power of the present day Holy Spirit.
