I. **Isaiah 1:18-19**

A. God’s Remembrance for this Year

1. The Year of The Mantle
 - What Did Elisha Say to Elijah?
 - A Prophetic Voice Ushering In a Prophetic Move
2. The Question is Never About God’s Willingness
 - Jesus settled this forever through not only what He said, but what He did (He healed everyone that came to Him, showing the God’s Good WILL Toward Man).
 - **Matthew 8:2-3** (The Leper).

B. Two Questions to Answer Today...

1. Are You Willing?
 - Are you in the same place as Elisha was with Elijah?
 - Are you Ready and Eager to Go the Extra Mile?
2. Are You Obedient?
 - The Real Question here is... **“Are you Quick to Obey?”**
 - Or Do you ask God for a sign, procrastinate, or get mad when it isn’t done the way you think it should be done?

II. The Power Within

A. Willing to Do What?

1. First....Willing to Listen (Not Just Hear... “I hear you” is not enough).
 - **Hearing is the passive, involuntary process of perceiving sound waves with your ears.**
 - **Listening is the active, voluntary, and learned skill of paying attention so you can understand what you are hearing.**
 - Hearing requires no effort, while listening requires mental focus and intention.
2. Second...Willing to Change (This requires submission and accountability)
 - Submission – that oh so feared word (I don’t want to do it that way!)
 - My Submission to God is My Response to His Goodness; I Submit to Him Willingly....Why? (**James 4:7-8**)

B. Obedient to What?

1. His Written Word...His Gentle Voice (**Hebrews 3:15, I John 2:20**)
2. **I John 5:2-3** (Going from Serving to Loving). Do you love God? Don’t just tell me...Show me! God is looking, but few are answering!
