



“Be Still”

- I. **Psalm 46:10**
 - A. Be Still
 1. “Step out of the traffic! Take a long loving look at me, the Most High God.”
 2. Be Quiet....Be Calm....So you can enter into His Rest.
 - B. And Know...
 1. What do you know?
 - Do you know God is Always With You?
 - Do you know if He is with you then He is always for you?
 - My People are destroyed for lack of knowledge...knowledge of His presence, knowledge of how to receive His promises, knowledge that He is God!
 2. You see, there is a difference in what you think you know and knowing that you know.....I know that I know that what God said in His Word and I know that it will never pass away; and because I Know, I don't have room for unbelief, questions, or any kind of fear. I Know God...He is God!
 3. Rest in the knowledge of His Presence
 - C. Be Still + Knowing that He is God = Rest
 1. **Psalm 91:1-2, 14-16**
 2. With all the busy-ness in this world, do God's people really know the true meaning of rest?
 3. **Mark 6:31** (the importance of finding that quiet place).

- II. **1 Kings 19:9-12**
 - A. The Still (Quiet, calm) Small voice of God
 1. **“Be still....so you can hear the still voice of God.”**
 2. God is not as much into “making noise” as He is finding followers that will just simply listen and obey.
 - Jesus consistently told people who received a miracle to keep it quiet.
 - Is it possible that this is one of the major problems in the church today?
 - B. Our focus – Hearing and Obeying (This is part of Knowing)
 1. There are many voices in this world and they all have one goal in mind: distract you from the still voice of God.
 2. **Isaiah 1:19** “If you are willing and obedient...”
 - C. “Peace, Be Still!” – **Mark 4:39**
 1. Be still – to Muzzle
 2. It's time to start speaking to the problem; it's time to start speaking to yourself; it's time to get closer to God – Be Still and Know!
